

Dr. Marie-France Tourigny-Rivard awarded 2014-2015 Best E-Portfolio Coach, Francophone Stream



The e-Portfolio programme was developed by the University of Ottawa's Faculty of Medicine to enhance the ability of medical students to reflect on the professional and personal aspects of their training. It is structured around the physician's roles identified in the undergraduate medical education curriculum's objectives and based on the CanMEDS model. It is designed to evaluate a student's ability to reflect on his or her role as a clinician, communicator, collaborator, manager, health advocate, scholar, professional, and person. It is a mandatory and summative component of the University of Ottawa's medical curriculum, and extends beyond the core focus of basic science knowledge and clinical skills.

Dr. Tourigny-Rivard excels in her capacity to teach this skillset to undergraduate students. Her guidance and interaction with students through scheduled meetings and the ePortfolio website provides them with a forum and medium by which to reflect on all roles of the physician. This recognition is rightly deserved.
